Oscar was a 1986 graduate of Carlisle High School and a 1990 graduate of the University of Central Arkansas at Conway. He was a Certified Public Accountant with a Master's degree in Business from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock and he served as a Captain in the Arkansas Army National Guard, 39th Infantry Brigade.

Oscar had the pleasure of serving as the Vice President of Customer

Service, Entergy Arkansas, and as the owner of ODS Enterprises, LLC, Gold Medal Flooring, and Genesis Construction.

One of Oscar's greatest gifts was being a disciple of Christ and freely serving others and the community. He was a Deacon at Saint Mark Baptist Church, Little Rock, Arkansas. He also demonstrated this by being a faithful volunteer, mentor, and leader for various organizations such as Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc., Big Brothers Big Sister's Agency of Pulaski County, Pulaski Technical College, Alumni Association for the University of Central Arkansas, the Arkansas Home Builder's Association, American Heart Association, and more.

Naccaman William is director of Special Projects for the Walton Family Foundation, which includes over-seeing large grants and managing other grantmaking organizations. A former junior and senior high school mathematics teacher, Dr. Williams has served in several higher education roles, including director of the P.K. Yonge Developmental Research School at the University of Florida, and assistant dean and director of minority education services in the College of Education at the University of Arkansas.

He served seven years on the Arkansas State Board of Education, including two years as chairman. He also served a four-year term on the Southern Regional Education Board. Dr. Williams has recently concluded five years on the Arkansas Charter School Authorizing Panel. He is



currently serving on the Winthrop Rockefeller Foundation board. Dr. Williams holds a bachelor's and master's degrees from Ouachita Baptist University and an Education Specialist degree and a doctorate in education administration from the University of Arkansas. He received the Martin Luther King, Jr. Faculty/Staff award in 1994 and the Martin Luther King, Jr. Lifetime Achievement Award in 2014 from the NWA MLK Council. He is a former infantry officer in the United States Army Reserve. He is also a member of Alpha Phi Alpha fraternity incorporated. Dr. Williams is a deacon, trustee and teacher at the Historic St. James Missionary Baptist Church in Fayetteville, Arkansas. He is married to Angela Williams and they have two sons, Naccaman Williams II— 29 and Nathan Williams — 25.

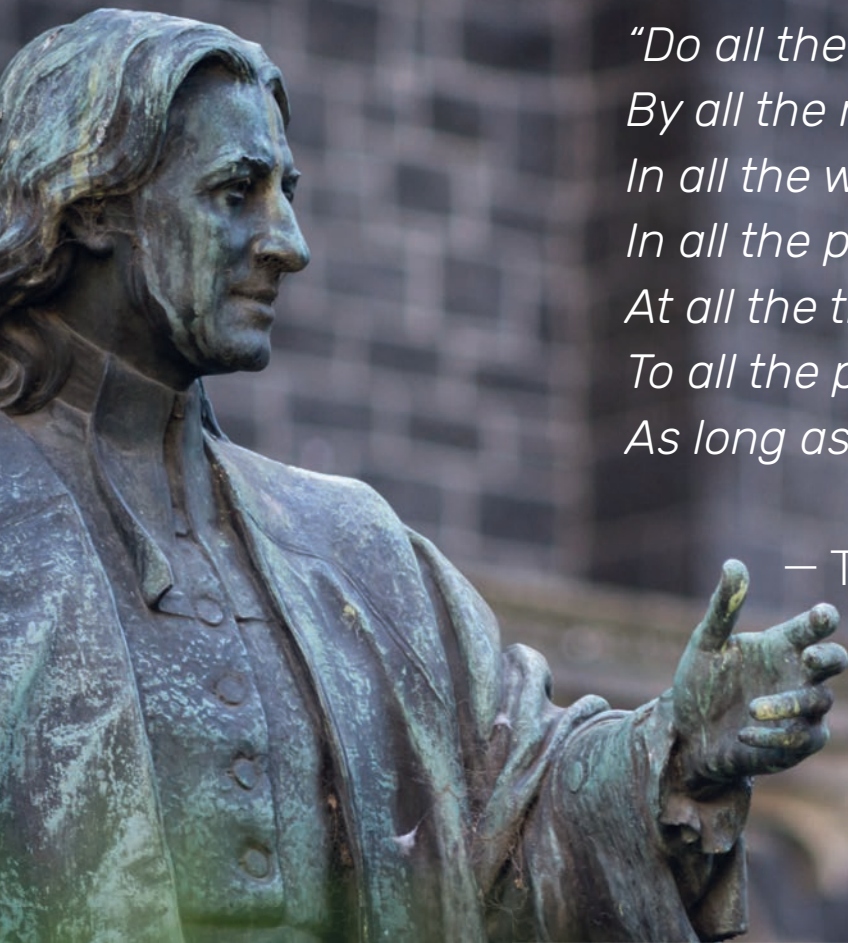

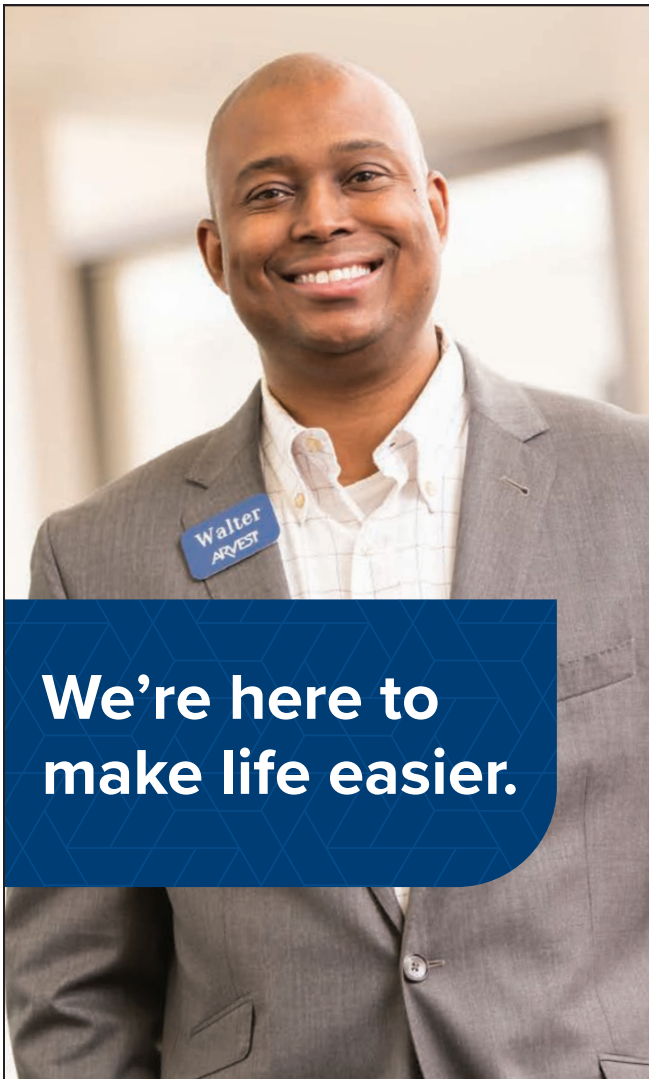
