He was a Certified Public Accountant with a Master's degree in Business from the University of Arkansas at Little Rock and he served as a Captain in the Arkansas Army National Guard, 39th Infantry Brigade.

Oscar had the pleasure of serving as the Vice President of Customer Service, Entergy Arkansas, and

as the owner of ODS Enterprises, LLC, Gold Medal Flooring, and Genesis Construction.

One of Oscar's greatest gifts was being a disciple of Christ and freely serving others and the community. He was a Deacon at Saint Mark Baptist Church, Little Rock, Arkansas. He also demonstrated this by being a faithful volunteer, mentor, and leader for various organizations such as Alpha Phi Alpha Fraternity Inc., Big Brothers Big Sister's Agency of Pulaski County, Pulaski Technical College, Alumni Association for the University of Central Arkansas, the Arkansas Home Builder's Association, American Heart Association, and more.

When we started this educational fund in 2018, our focus was to give financial assistance to a few high school seniors that were going to college. Since that time, we have expanded our efforts in the area of education to include the OWJ Internship Initiative - assisting our scholars in obtaining paid summer internships in their field of study. We also started the Oscar Juniors program where we have adopted three local elementary schools and, in partnership with First Security Bank, we make financial deposits into the student saver accounts of elementary students who are nominated based on good grades, conduct and attendance.

Last year, our team committed to doing more. We introduced our OWJ Continuing Scholars grant for 2024. We select a minimum of two college students, who are not previous OWJ scholarship recipients, and award a \$1,500 grant to each student. Our inaugural grant recipients are listed below.

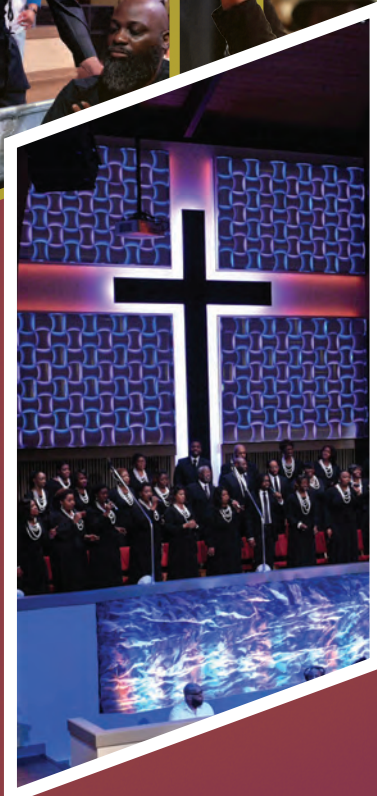

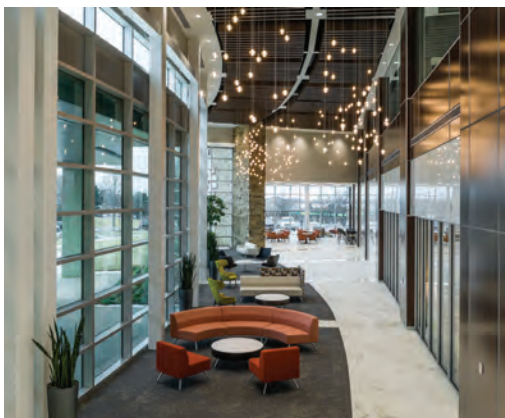
